Carex Working Group is pleased to offer a workshop on sedge identification on July 16-17, 2014. This two-day workshop will emphasize sedges of the southern California. The first day will be spent in the lab learning sedge morphology and terminology and keying fresh and dried material. Participants are encouraged to bring their own plants to work on. The second day will be spent in the field and will emphasize field identification and ecology of sedges.

This workshop will be useful for resource managers, wetland consultants, natural area managers, restoration planners, and anyone who wants to cultivate an irrational passion for the less showy plant groups. Workshop participants should have basic plant identification skills.

## Workshop Materials

Keys: We will supply the Carex key we have written for the forthcoming field guide to the sedges of California for use in the workshop. We will also be selling the recently published "Field Guide to the Sedges of the Pacific Northwest, Second Edition" for those wishing to buy a copy.
